The course aims to provide insights into the dynamics of family formation and dissolution in contemporary societies.

After an illustration of the Second Demographic Transition process, a general overview of the process of transition to adulthood, dealing with differences across societies and generations, will be considered. Then, the course will focus on union formation and union dissolution processes, considering their correlates, times, and ways of diffusion. Finally, the nexus between family life courses and subjective well-being will be explored.
